GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

READ *North Carolina Auctioneer Laws, Rules and Regulations:* N.C.G.S. 85B, 21 NCAC 4B. These are available on the Board's website at www.ncalb.org.

READ CAREFULLY each provision of the application and the instructions. The application must be properly completed, signed, notarized, accompanied by all required documents, proper fees, and dated no more than *thirty (30) days* prior to when your application is received by the office of the North Carolina Auctioneer Licensing Board (NCALB). It must be received, not postmarked, in the NCALB Office on, or before the Board deadline date established by the Board (dates enclosed). If any part of the application is incorrect or incomplete, or if required attachments are not included, the application may be returned, resulting in a delay in the licensing process.

The applicant on the auction firm application must be the owner, if the business is a sole proprietorship; a partner, if a partnership; an officer of the corporation, if incorporated, or a member manager, if a limited liability company.

Type or print legibly in ink, and mail the competed application to the Board office. Application may not be submitted by email or fax.

Remember to enclose a certified check, money order, or cashier's check payable to the North Carolina Auctioneer Licensing Board (NCALB). If the funds are NOT submitted in the proper form and amount, the application will not be accepted. The application fee is non-fundable.

If applying for an Auction Firm License with a non-auctioneer as a designated person, a firm exam is required pursuant to N.C.G.S. 85B-4(g). This office will contact you either by email (preferred method) or phone regarding scheduling and other exam information. If you are an auctioneer licensed in NC, you are exempt from the firm exam.

- Copy of each director(s), officer(s), partner(s), and/or designated person(s) high school diploma or proof of equivalency, college diploma or transcript from high school or college. You must be 18 years old and have graduated from high school or equivalent pursuant to N.C.G.S. 85B-4(b).
- Local Criminal History Records Search. See Out of State Auction Firm License Application Instructions for details.
- Fingerprint Card and Authority to Release Form. See Out of State Auction Firm License Application Instructions for details.
- A copy of any applicable certified Articles of Incorporation, Articles of Organization , Assumed Name Certificate, or Partnership Agreement.
- Written detailed statement for questions #22 through #28 if you answered "YES." Complete details must be given. Attach a separate statement.
- Security Information Form.
- Employee Classification Form.
- Letter of Good Standing. See Out of State Auction Firm License Application Instructions for details.
- Designation of Agent for Service of Process form. See Out of State Auction Firm License Application Instructions for details.

Out of State Auction Firm License Instructions

NOTE: If you currently hold an active North Carolina Auctioneer License, you do not have to provide documents listed in 2 and 3 below, or submit the fingerprint processing fee.

- 1. Criminal history records search by the Clerk of Superior Court (or equivalent official in other jurisdictions) in each county where the owner(s), director(s), officer(s), partner(s) and/or designated person(s) has resided and maintained a business within the last 60 months (five years). Each original document must be validated by having the Clerk's official stamp or seal attached and dated no more than 30 days prior to the NCALB office receiving your application.
- 2. A copy of each director(s), officer(s), partner(s), and/or designated person(s) high school diploma or proof of equivalency. The NCALB will only accept a GED or high school diploma issued by accredited institutions. A college diploma, high school transcript or college transcript is acceptable.
- 3. Fingerprint card, Fee, and Authority of Information to Release Form pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 85B-3.2; Each director(s), officer(s), partner(s), and/or designated person(s) is required to complete a Release of Information form, a fingerprint card, and pay the processing fee to this Board. The fingerprints must be obtained by a law enforcement agency, such as the Police Department or Sheriff's Office. Each relevant person and the official taking the fingerprints must complete the card. The fingerprint lines/ridges must be clearly visible. This card may be obtain from your local Police Department or Sheriff's Office or this office, upon request, will mail you one.

*If any owner(s) officer(s),partner(s) and/or designated person(s) has resided less than 5 years in NC, the fee is \$38.00, otherwise it is \$14.00.

- 5. A copy of any applicable certified Articles of Incorporation, Articles of Organization, Partnership Agreement or Assumed Name Certificate.
- 6. Social Security Information Form.
- 7. Employee Classification Form.
- 8. An original letter of good standing (license status) from each and every Board and Commission where the applicant firm and each officer(s), director(s), partner(s) and/or designated person(s) holds a valid auctioneering license of any type. The letter(s) shall be dated no more than 30 days prior to the NCALB office receiving your application.
- 9. A properly completed "Designation of Agent for Service of Process" form, complete with notarized signature. A form is required for the auction firm, each officer(s), director(s), partner(s) and/or designated person(s) listed on the application
- 10. Two letters of credit reference that must be dated no more than 30 days prior to when the NCALB office receives your application (One must be from a banking institution).

RESTRICTIONS AND EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Authority to transact business under a firm license is limited to the person or persons so designated in the application. The designated person or persons are required to satisfactorily pass a written examination on the Auctioneer Law and Rules. A currently licensed North Carolina auctioneer who is the designated person is not required to take the auction firm examination.

Licensed real estate brokers and real estate firms are exempt from the examination so long as they are involved in the selling of real property only (no personal property) at auction, and provided that they employ or associate themselves with a licensed auctioneer (requires Firm License) to handle those aspects of the transactions peculiar to the auctioneer profession.

The auction firm examination may be taken at the Board's office in Fuquay-Varina. Please contact the staff at (919)567-2844 for further information.

ESCROW ACCOUNT REQUIREMENTS

N.C.G.S. § 85B-7.1 Handling Clients Funds of the Auctioneers Law, and 21 NCAC 4B .0603 of the Rules and Regulations specifies the requirements concerning escrow accounts. Money, which has come into your possession through an auction sale, which is payable to the auctioneer or firm, and any portion that belongs to others, may not be commingled with your own under any circumstances N.C.G.S. § 85B-8(a)(7). In addition, such funds must be deposited in a trust or escrow account in a bank or savings and loan association **located in North Carolina**, within three business days of receiving the funds. Funds, which are disbursed to the seller on auction day, are not subject to the escrow account requirements; however, the Law and Rules specify certain record keeping requirements.

If you have any questions concerning these requirements, you should contact this office.

IMPORTANT

Properly answering questions on the application

The North Carolina Auctioneer Licensing Board has the authority to deny a license if there is any misrepresentation by the applicant. Accordingly, read each question carefully on the application and answer correctly.

Have you ever been **charged** or **arrested** with a criminal offense (other than minor traffic offenses; DUI/DWI are **not** minor traffic offenses)? If yes, attach a separate statement giving complete details. You must disclose a charge or arrest even though it was later dismissed. Note: You will be asked about convictions in the following question.

Have you ever been **convicted** of any criminal offense (other than minor traffic offenses; DUI/DWI are **not** minor traffic offenses) or is there any criminal charge now pending against you? If yes, attach a separate statement giving complete details. If the final disposition of the matter is dismissal, there is no conviction. If you plead guilty, or are found guilty after trial or a fine is accessed and paid by the applicant on the initial charge or any related charge, this will be considered a conviction and must be disclosed.

The authority for the denial of a license is found in N.C.G.S. 85B-3.1(a)(3); N.C.G.S. 85B-8(a)(1); and 21 NCAC 4B .0404(a)(2) and (6), that state as follows:

N.C.G.S. 85B-3.1(a)(3)

(a) The Commission shall have the following powers and duties: ... (3) To deny, suspend, and revoke licenses pursuant to G.S. 85B-8 ...

N.C.G.S. 85B-8(a)(1)

- (a) The following shall be grounds for the assessment of a civil penalty in accordance with G.S. 85B-3.1(b) or the denial, suspension, or revocation of an auctioneer, auctioneer apprentice or auction firm license: (1) Any violation of this Chapter or any violation of a rule or regulation duly adopted by the Commission...; and

 - (a) The Board may assess a civil penalty in accordance with G.S. 85B-3.1(b) or deny, suspend, or revoke a license, or issue a letter of reprimand to a licensee, upon any of the following grounds: (2) violation of any provision of the Rules under 21 NCAC, Subchapter 4B ... (6) failure to properly, completely and fully complete an application or making any false statement or giving any false information in connection with an application for a license, renewal or reinstatement of a license...

The examination was designed to determine if the designated person has a working knowledge of the Auctioneer Law and Rules. The examination involves a possible score of 100 points; with a required minimum score of 75 points to pass the examination.

Authority to transact business under a firm license is limited to the person or persons so designated in the application. The designated person or persons are required to satisfactorily pass a written examination on the Auctioneer Law and Rules **prior** to being licensed. A licensed auctioneer who is the designated person for a firm is <u>not</u> required to take the auction firm examination.

Licensed real estate brokers and real estate firms are <u>exempt</u> from the auction firm examination so long as they are involved in the selling of real property only at auction, and provided that they employ or associate themselves with a licensed auctioneer to handle those aspects of the transactions peculiar to the auctioneer profession.

The auction firm examination is given in Fuquay-Varina at the Board's offices. The office will contact you regarding the auction firm exam information upon receipt of the firm application, supporting documents, and fees. If you have any questions, you may contact the staff at (919)567-2844.

All applications and supporting documentation are subject to the approval of the Licensing Board.

INFORMATION THAT MAY BE HELPFUL IN PREPARING FOR THE EXAMINATION

- 1. Be thoroughly familiar with the North Carolina Auctioneers Law and the North Carolina Auctioneer Licensing Board Rules and Regulations. There are available on the Board's website at www.ncalb.org.
- 2. On the Board's website under Resources is a video titled "Tips for Taking the Designated Person/Auction Firm Exam" that is very helpful as well as other informative information.
- 3. An applicant should have sufficient educational background to be able to read with comprehension.
- 4. Prior experience as an apprentice auctioneer, or any experience gained by working at auctions as a clerk, cashier, or groundsman will be helpful.

Persons experienced in the sale of goods or real estate at auction may be a helpful source of information.
