NC EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 155

Governor Roy Cooper recently signed Executive Order No. 155, regarding COVID-19. Executive Order 155 took effect on Friday, August 7 at 5 p.m., and remains in effect until 5 p.m. on September 11, unless replaced or rescinded by a subsequent Executive Order. Please review the Order carefully, as it **includes mandates involving Mass Gathering Limits, Social Distancing, Face Coverings, and other issues relevant to auction activity**.
